At the town hall citizens c "Bürgerbüro", the most important errands can therefore be accomplished in one visit.

The citizens' office registers not only the newcomers but also their cars; it takes care of passport matters, runs a lost-and-fou more. And the citizens' office is available in digital ways, too. The website of the City of Würzburg provides a listing of docum hall visitors should take along for their requests. To avoid waiting in line, you can also schedule your <u>appointment online</u>.

Primary Residence campaign

Studying at one of the three Würzburg universities and moving one's primary residence to Würzburg means cash in hand: the contributes 30 Euros to the semester ticket for all newly arrived students for two entire semesters.
