#### Catalogue

Consult our catalogue on the computers at the library or via our website at www.stadtbuecherei-wuerzburg.de (or if you're using a mobile device via http://wuerzburg.mobilopac. de). Are you looking for the author or the title of a book? Would you like to compile lists of literature about specific topics, download these lists or save them for later use? Would you like to view your own borrowing record, showing the media that you currently have on loan? Would you like to renew these loans, request or reserve media? Our catalogue is able to suit all those requirements and a good deal more!

#### Information desks

If you have any questions you can find us at the information desks located on the ground floor, the first floor or in the children's and youth library. Our trained personnel are also available for quick researches on the internet.

#### Internet

On the first floor or in the studio (third floor) you'll find computers providing public internet access and also one computer equipped with word processing. In addition, the café on the ground floor offers free WiFi. Our team also provides introductions for beginners – for detailed topics please see our information brochures or visit our website www. stadtbuecherei-wuerzburg.de. You can also catch up on our stock, services and events there.



Books and sheet music may be kept for four weeks; periodicals, CDs, CD-ROMs and documentary films for two weeks and movies for one week.

The loan period of the borrowed media may be renewed one week before the due date at the earliest, if not requested by another user. You can renew your media (except movies) either personally, by phone or of course directly via the online catalogue.

#### Registration

In order to obtain a library card you must present an official proof of your place of residence. Therefore please bring your personal identification card with you. We also accept your passport or driving licence, though only in conjunction with a confirmation of residence.

Your library card is transferable to your wife or husband. Please inform us immediately if your card is lost or stolen as well as a change of address. The card holder respectively the legal representative will be liable for any misuse of the library card, including lost or damaged media.

#### Reservation

Items, borrowed by another user, can be reserved. You'll be informed by mail, e-mail or via SMS as soon as the item has been returned. Items which are not on loan can also be ordered in advance directly via the online catalogue.







